

5 Basic Rules

for

Water Resistant Watches

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- 1.** Keep the winding button (crown) screwed in at all times. (If screw-down model)
- 2.** Do NOT push the push-buttons when the watch is submerged. (if it has push-buttons)
- 3.** If the watch receives an impact, e.g. falls on the ground, be sure to have its water resistance verified before subjecting it to wet conditions again.
- 4.** If the watch comes into contact with chlorinated or salt water, be sure to rinse off with fresh water immediately after.
- 5.** Rotate the bezel (if it is a rotating model) to flush out any salt, sand and debris.

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
